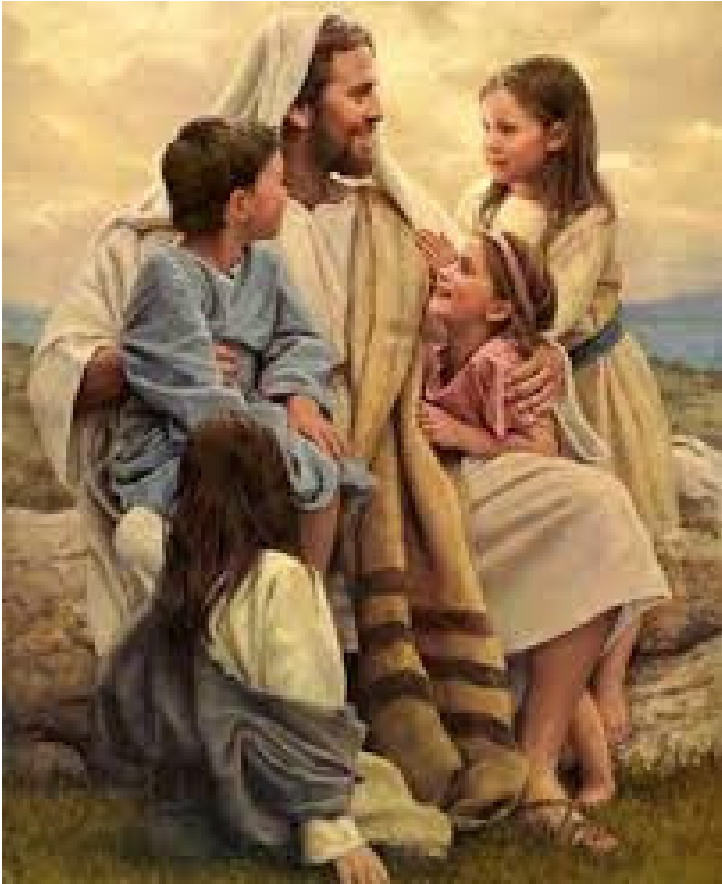


MARCH 2021 NEWSLETTER

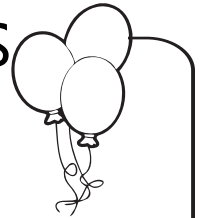
